Dear Parents/Guardians,

We thank you for the strong partnership in supporting our school efforts. The following are important updates that require your attention:

27 July 2020, Monday (GCE O-Level MTL Listening Comprehension)

Please note that 27 July 2020 is scheduled for GCE O-Level MTL Listening Comprehension Examination. To allow the preparation of the venues and conduct of the examination, there will be early dismissal for all Sec 1 to 3 students as follows:

Sec 1: 12.40 pm

Sec 2: 12.50 pm

Sec 3: 1 pm

There will be no 2nd recess break for students and they are advised to leave the school compound upon dismissal. The subject teacher for Periods 7 and 8 will advise the students on the assignments for the lessons missed.

The Sec 4N students will be dismissed at about 12.15pm, after their Preliminary Examination for that day.

For the Sec 4 and 5 candidates taking the MTL Listening Comprehension Examination, they will take their second break at 12.45pm at the school canteen and report for the examination at 1.45pm. Those not taking the examination will be dismissed at 12.45pm.

7 August 2020, Friday (National Day Commemoration)

School will be celebrating National Day on 7 August 2020. Lessons will be conducted for the first 3 periods to 9.35am, followed by the National Day Celebrations.

As part of the celebrations, we encourage students to come in national colours of red and/ or white. School will end at 10.30am. There will not be recess breaks on 7 August 2020 and we encourage the students to take their breakfast before reporting to school.


As National Day falls on Sunday, 9 August 2020, the next day 10 August 2020 will be a public holiday. School will only be open on Tuesday, 11 August 2020.
